

# Am I eligible to declare?

## Psychology Declaration Requirements

**Math Requirement** (Courses AM or MATH 3 or 4 or 11A or 11B; OR Tests: 300+ on the ALEKS Math Placement or a 3+ on the AP Calculus Exam) earn a minimum grade of C or Pass

**PSYC 1-Introduction to Psychology** (or 4+ on AP Psychology) earn a minimum grade of B-  
*\*NOTE: If a grade of C or C+ was earned in PSYC 1, a grade of B- or higher must be earned in PSYC 10*

**PSYC 2- Introduction to Psychology Statistics** (or STAT 5 or STAT 7/7L or score of 4+ on AP Statistics) earn a minimum grade of B-

**\*\*PSYC 1 & PSYC 2 must be taken for a letter grade (also PSYC 10 if a B- was not earned in PSYC 1)\*\***

## Cognitive Science Declaration Requirements

**Calculus** (Courses AM or MATH 3 or 4, or MATH 11A or 19 or 20, or score of 4+ in AP Calculus AB, score of 3+ in AP Calculus BC, or score of 60+ in CLEP Calculus)

**Programming** (CSE 13E or 13S or 20 or 30, or CMPS 5C or 5J or 5P, or 3+ in AP Computer Science A)

**PSYC 2: Introduction to Psychology Statistics** (or STAT 5 or STAT 7/7L or score of 3+ on AP STATS)

### **PSYC 20: Cognition, Fundamental Theories**

Must have an **overall 2.8 GPA** or higher in the required lower division declaration requirements. Must earn a grade of C or higher in each course (or indicated score).

*\*Use a [GPA calculator](#) to determine your eligibility (leave requirements met through test scores out of calculation).*

**\*\*All Courses Above Must be Taken for a Letter Grade\*\***  
*If you took a course P/NP on accident you will need to calculate that Pass as a C grade in the GPA calculation.*
