REQUIRED COURSES FOR THE PSYCHOLOGY MINOR

Courses to complete BEFORE declaring the minor:

- Math Requirement Courses: AMS 2 or 3, or Math 3 or 4 or 11A, or 11B; **OR**
 Tests: 31+ on Math Placement or a 3, 4 or 5 on the AP exam
- Psych 1 Introduction to Psychology
- Psych 2 Introduction to Psychology Statistics* (or AMS 5 or AMS 7*)

Courses to complete before taking upper division courses:

- Psych 10 Introduction to Developmental Psychology*
- Psych 100** Research Methods in Psychology* (1/2 DC)

*These courses have pre-requisites.

Major and Minor Admissions Policy

To be admitted to the major or minor, students must demonstrate the attainment of foundational skills by receiving a grade of at least B- (2.7) in (a) Psychology 1 and (b) Psychology 2 or Applied Mathematics and Statistics 5 or 7/L. For the complete policy, please see the psychology department website.

RECOMMENDED: Psych 20, 40, 60, and Bio 70. These courses may be needed as prerequisites for upper-division courses. REVIEW upper-division course descriptions in the University Catalog.
